## **TERMINATION NOTICE**

**RE: ENFIELD FARMERS MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANY, IN LIQUIDATION**

On January 24, 2012, an Agreed Order of Liquidation with a Finding of Insolvency was entered against Enfield Farmers Mutual Insurance Company ("EFM"), by the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois. In connection therewith, the Court has ordered that EFM be Liquidated in accordance with the Illinois Insurance Code, 215 ILCS 5/187, *et seq.*, and further ordered that all in force EFM policies be terminated, effective upon the entry of the Agreed Order of Liquidation on January 24, 2012, and that all coverage afforded under the policy will cease effective at the date indicated, unless the policy has been terminated at an earlier date.

A claim filing deadline will be established by the Supervising court, in order for all potential claims against EFM to be presented, valued, and paid on a *pro rata* basis from the assets of the EFM estate.

- Claimants who may have a claim for Unearned Premium need not file a proof of claim form.
- Claimants who have pending claims that were previously asserted against EFM need not file a proof of claim form.
- Claimants who may have a claim that has not previously been reported to EFM must file a proof of claim form on or before the claim filing deadline that is established by the Supervising Court.

Please contact your insurance agent or broker for assistance with the replacement of your insurance policy.
